Trusts and Grants Update – Autumn 2022

The Hugh Fraser Foundation has awarded Seamab a grant of £4,000 towards our children taking part in Epic Adventures. £1,100 of this grant has been used to purchase new scooters for the children with the remainder being used to purchase Parkour sessions for our children to enjoy as part of their Epic Adventures.

We are very grateful to the Trustees of **Dr Guthrie's Association** in awarding Seamab a grant of £1,104 which was granted to allow us to use in any way that met the needs of the organisation. As a result of their generous grant, we were able to purchase a sewing machine that the children can use whilst at school.

All of the bikes purchased have been chosen by the children to best suit their needs.



We have been awarded a grant of £2,853 from **Education Scotland – Food for Thought Programme** which will be a welcome addition to the school curriculum going forward. This will give the children the opportunity to plant and grow their own produce once we have purchased the poly-tunnel as part of the grant award.
